She's always wanted to ride a train, and why not this one?

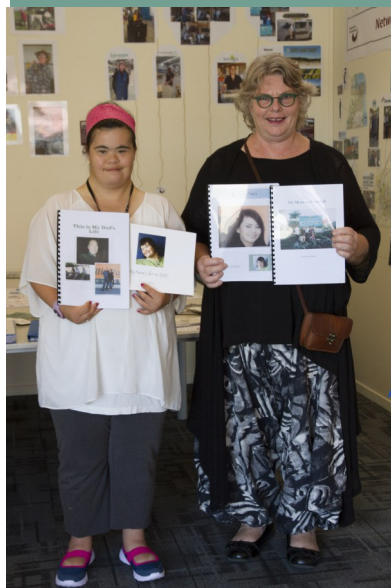

DRC had our Open Day on Friday 16th February. The next few pages are dedicated to this so you can feel like you were a part of the fun!! We had over 60 visitors on the day.

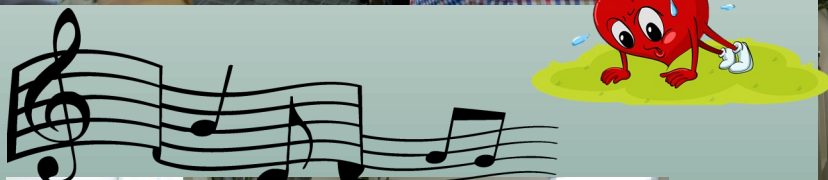
