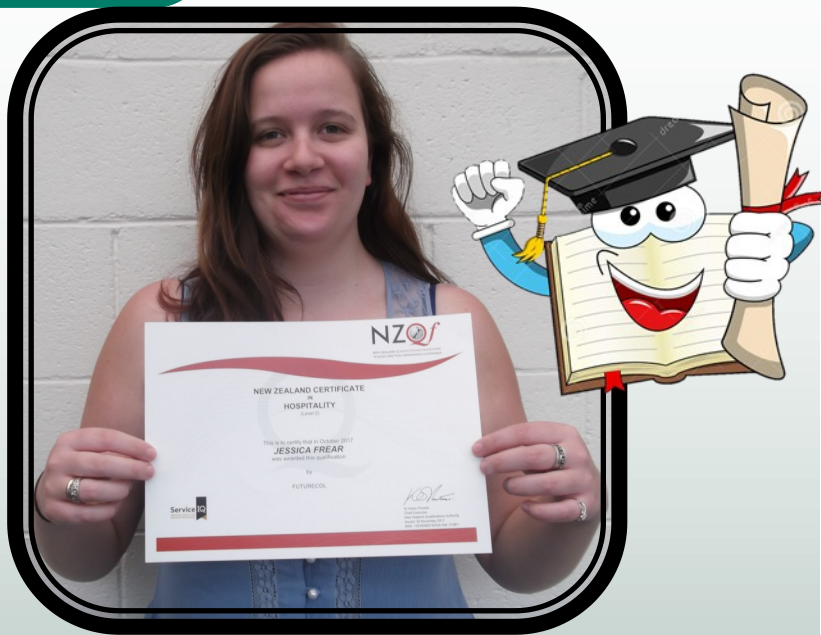

Hmmmm, I wonder if they do house calls...?? I could do with a night off...!

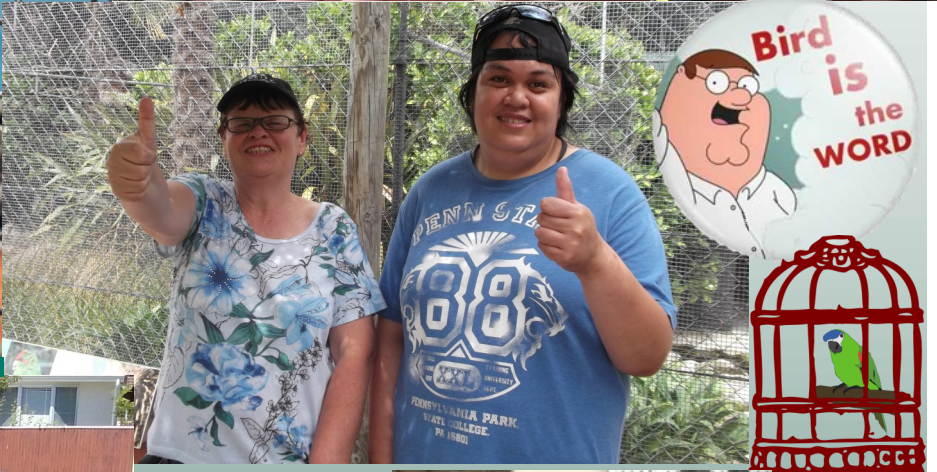

Should be **AWESOME** when it's finished!



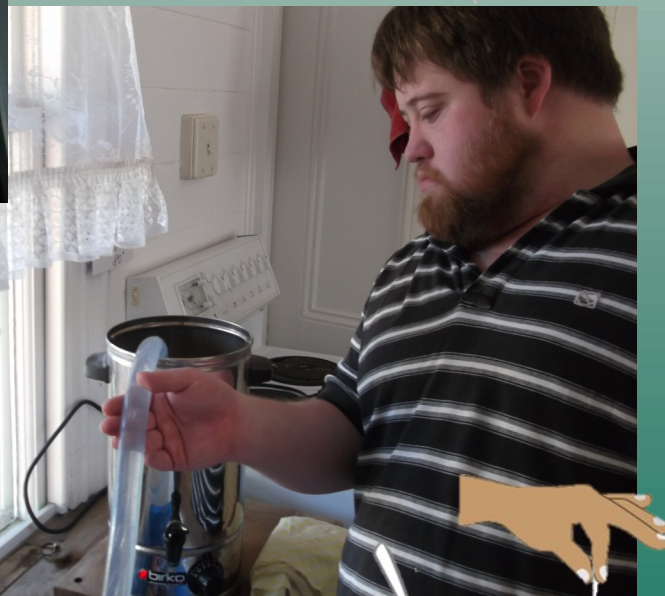
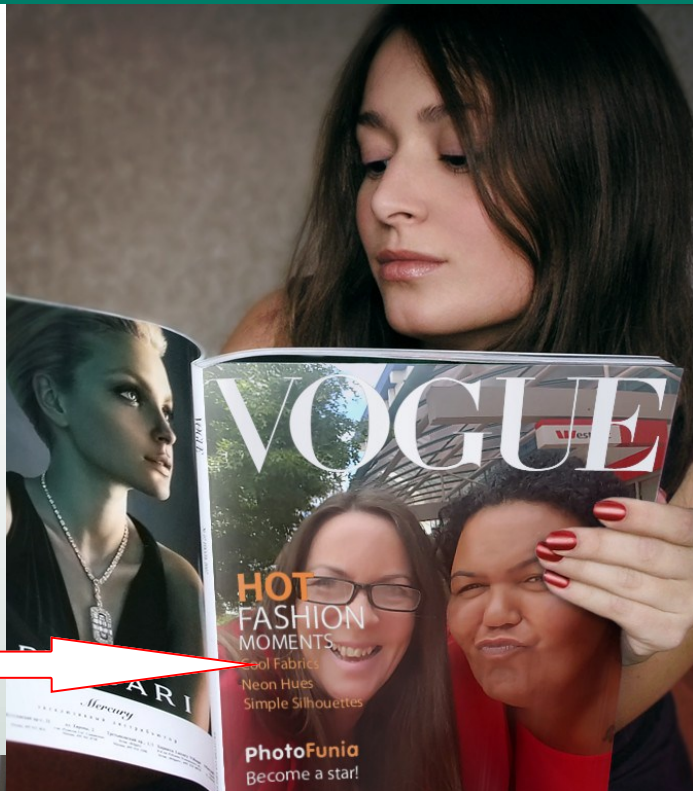
Paul works at Hey Hoe Engineering and really loves his job.
